A DAY IN THE LIFE OF A YOUTH TEAM VOLUNTEER



GET READY for an action-packed, exciting adventure as a Youth Team volunteer!

IN THE LEAD UP TO THE FESTIVAL we will have a zoom call for preevent online team training, to make sure everyone is prepared before they arrive on site.

IT ALL KICKS OFF ON THURSDAY 21ST with a team meeting, essential safeguarding training, and a powerful time of worship to set the tone for an unforgettable experience.

FRIDAY, SATURDAY AND SUNDAY MORNING? The buzz starts early! The team will gather at 8:00 am for pre-programme prayer, a quick rundown of the day's plan, and a venue check to make sure everything's set and ready to go. As the young people start rolling in from 8:45 am, it's all about making those connections. There'll be some fun, engaging content to warm up the crowd before we officially kick things off at 9:30 am.

ONCE THE PROGRAMME BEGINS, BUCKLE UP! It's a jam-packed two and a half hours filled with worship, inspiring talks, lively small group discussions, surprise guest appearances, and, of course, a whole lot of fun!

BY 12 PM, we'll wrap up the morning's programme, followed by a quick team debrief and a time to pray together. Then, we'll reset the venue and get it ready for the rest of the day's action.

BREAK TIME! The youth team gets some much-needed downtime from 12:30pm until 5:30pm, to enjoy the Festival.

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN THE EVENINGS? Over the next three days, there will be some detached youthwork shifts, where the youth team will roam the site, checking in with young people and making sure everyone's having a blast and staying safe. You'll be assigned up to two shifts with each being approximately 3.5 hours long. Before and after each shift, make sure to check in at the Youth Hub, and always share any safeguarding concerns immediately.

SOWHAT ARE THE PERKS?

Joining as a volunteer as part of the youth team looks like getting fully involved with 100% commitment. The perks you receive are as follows:

- Free meals when you are on shift keeping you well-fueled!
- Free access to the whole festival including plenty of time to roam around and lose yourself in the music when you are not on shift.
- Access to the exclusive Big Church volunteer camping and hospitality area where you can unwind if needed!
- Free phone charging facilities to keep your phone juiced up.
- The exciting opportunity to make lots of new friends, insight into how an event like Big Church Festival happens, as well as use your gifts and skills to serve the young people!

It's the most incredible and exciting 3 days at a Festival like no other, where you will have countless opportunities to invest into young people's lives and their faith in Jesus.
